






Instructions:

1. Cut along the dotted line.
2. With the square design facing you, fold along the diagonals away from you. Crease.
3. Now fold along the main body square towards you. You should have all the points meeting in the center. Crease.
4. Fold in half horizontally. Crease. Unfold this last one only.
5. Fold in half vertically. Crease. Unfold this last one only.
6. Flip upside down. Tuck your thumb and forefinger in each pocket. Now play!
